1 USB Smart Card Reader

1.1 Installing the USB drives

It's important to strictly follow the instruction manual when installing the USB drivers. See the section describing your operating system.

You can download the latest version of MLCard, containing the USB drivers from our homepage: http://www.megalink.no

NB!

The card reader is the SCR335 from SCM Microsystems. It's important that the correct driver is installed. Make sure that WindowsTM do **not** download drivers itself. MLCard does only work with this specific card reader.

MLCard must be version 8.10 or higher.



1.1.1 Windows Vista

Windows Vista installs the driver without asking the user. Thus you have to manually override the driver setup.


Please do the following:

Close all open applications. Connect the Smart Card Reader and wait until Vista displays the "Installed new devices" dialog.




Then open the Start Menu and start the "device manager" application.






Right click the device "USB Smart Card Reader", located under Smart Card readers, and open the Proterties dialog.






Press "Update Driver".






Select "Browse my computer for driver, manually".



Browse to the folder MLCard is located and press **Next** >.


1.1.2 Windows XP SP2

Before you begin, close all active applications running on your computer, including MLRange. Connect the Smart Card Reader to the computer.

Windows will automatically detect your new device. The following dialog will appear:




Select No, not this time and press \underline{N} ext >.



Select Install from a list or specific location (Advanced) and press Next >.






Select <u>Search</u> for the best driver in these locations. and enable ONLY Include this <u>location</u> in the search: Browse to the folder MLCard is located. Then press <u>Next</u> >.




Select Continue Anyway.

1.1.3 Windows 2000

Before you begin, close all active applications running on your computer, including MLRange. Connect the Smart Card Reader to the computer.

Windows will automatically detect your new device. The following dialog will appear:






Press Next >.
